Institutional Policy for Continuous Internal Evaluation (CIE)

The Continuous Internal Evaluation (CIE) regulations are governed by the principles of the College Assessment and Learning Policy. It recognizes that assessment is an integral part of the learning process and not simply a measurement of it, i. e. assessment of, for and as learning.

The policy encompasses the following five principles:

- 1. Assessment will promote learning.
- 2. Feedback is a core component of the assessment.
- 3. Assessment will be considered at the programme level.
- 4. Assessment will be fair, ethical and learner-centred.
- 5. Good practice will be supported.

The CIE procedures apply to all elements of student assessment except for final examinations. It may include practical exercises and examinations, written assignments, projects, oral presentations, open-book tests and performances depending on the programme of study and the individual.

The function of continuous assessment is to facilitate student learning by:

- Reinforcing and expanding students` learning
- Measuring and certifying students` Learning
- Assessing the students' practical application of course material as well as their theoretical knowledge in each course

Providing feedback to students

• Motivating students to work throughout the programme

• Supporting diversity in learning styles among students

The outcome-based education committee will develop a general strategy on the types of assessment and the proportion of marks to be devoted to each piece of continuous assessment work across the whole programme, in order to achieve a level of consistency across courses and stages within the programme and to ensure that all of the learning outcomes for the programme can be achieved and measured.

The College has established Continuous Internal Evaluation Committee. The role of the committee is to conduct internal examination and declare the result in time. The committee conducts meetings regularly and has fruitful discussions on related issues. The committee includes a convener and members from the various departments.

Roles and Responsibilities of the CIE Committee:

1. Prepare the timetable for internal examinations following the college academic

calendar.

2. Preparation for smooth conduction of CIE tests such as display of test schedule, invigilation duty chart, seat allotment in the test conducting halls, assignment

of test duties to faculty, internal squads etc.

3. Informing the HoDs to submit the course-wise test analysis after each test is completed and later preparing the report to submit to IQAC for further reviews and for follow-up action to be taken by the course teacher, if any, for further .

improvement.

Monitoring and Review:

The said policy is monitored and periodically reviewed by the IQAC of the College.
