21st and 22nd January, 2022

Fourth National Conference on 'Recent Trends in Pure and Applied Sciences' was organized by Internal Quality Assurance Cell on virtual mode on 21st and 22nd January, 2022. The main object of this conference was to share knowledge and to discuss on highly current issues in pure and applied sciences.

More than 170 people from the different states were participated in this online mode National conference. Out of these 100 were faculty members and 70 were students.
