Report of Student Satisfaction Survey 2021-2022

The Student Satisfaction Survey was conducted by IQAC of BVDPKM. All students enrolled during spring 2021-22 were invited to participate in this online survey through what's group. An Online Google form for the same was created and shared to whatsapp groups of students, so that it can reach each and every student of the college. The students participated voluntarily, the survey was implemented online, and respondents were ensured confidentiality.

Each question in the SSS format is aimed at collecting the factual opinion of students on teaching and learning activities, overall impressions, and suggestions about the college. The data set comprises representative sampling and convenience sampling. The collected data points are analysed on a 5-point Likert scale. The scale measures the responses as very good, good, fair, satisfactory, and unsatisfactory. This simple but important exercise definitely helps to improve the relevance of teaching and learning.

Analysis and Interpretation:

A) Primary information

- Out of the total respondents 97.2% of the students are of the view that the depth of the course content and positive approach of teachers during teaching the subject.
- ❖ 82.3 % of students agree that extending the course coverage is good.

B) About the Department

- ❖ 85.6% of students opined positively about teachers' knowledge in the subject' thorough Preparation before coming to the classes.
- ❖ 86.4% of students agree that teachers can communicate effectively and the remaining 9.1 % of students also gave positive feedback about teachers' communications with positive commitment.
- ❖ 97% of students opined positive approach of teachers during teaching and they generate interest in the subject.
- ❖ 84.4% of students gave positive feedback about fair internal evaluation done by teachers.

- ❖ 84.2 % of students agreed that teachers usually gave the assignments during classes and also discuss the performance given by students in those assignments.
- ❖ 86.2% of students have appreciated that the teachers always inform them about expected competencies, course outcomes, and program outcomes before each lecture.
- ❖ According to the survey, 84.9% of students have said that their mentor always took a necessary follow-up with an assigned task with them.
- ❖ 85.9% of students have appreciated that teachers always illustrate the various concepts through different examples with real-life applications.
- ❖ Above 90% of students replied that teachers identify the student's strengths and weaknesses and encourage them by providing the right level of challenges to overcome their weaknesses.
- ❖ 90% of students appreciated the teachers for using various ICT tools such as LCD projectors, multimedia, etc., while during teaching.


C) About all aspects of college:


- ❖ 397 students participated in the survey out of these 71% of students opined that the institute always takes an active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, and field visit opportunities for students.
- ❖ Above 80% of students gave positive feedback about the teaching and mentoring process in the institution facilities them in cognitive, social, and emotional growth.
- ❖ According to a survey above 80% of students replied that the institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.
- ❖ 82.6% of students agree that institution makes positive efforts to engage students in the monitoring, review, and continuous quality improvement of the teaching-learning process.
- ❖ 83.9% of students appreciated to institute and teachers about the use of student-centric methods, participative learning, and problem-solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.
- ❖ 85.4% of students have agreed that the teachers encourage them to participate in extracurricular activities run by the college and Universities which are useful for the progressive growth of students.

- ❖ A Maximum number of students i.e., 90.4% agree that institutions and teachers make efforts to inculcate soft skills, life skills, and employability skills to make them ready for the world of work.
- ❖ 85.6% of students have said that the overall quality of the teaching-learning process in the institute is very good.




It can be concluded from the above analysis that the majority of the students are satisfied with the quality of the teaching-learning process in the institute is very good














































Observation/suggestions to improve the overall teaching-learning experience in institution:
