Conference Report

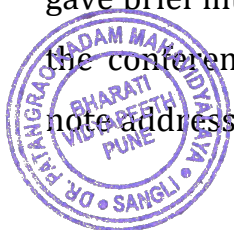
First National Conference on Recent Trends in Pure and Applied Sciences

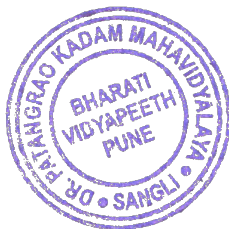


The third session was reserved for poster presentation. Total 44 posters were presented by researchers and students. The evaluation of posters were carried out by expert committee.
