
Topic of the webinar was Sustainable Menstruation & Impact of Sanitary pads on Health & Environment. In the beginning, introduction of webinar was given by convener of the webinar Dr. Prabha Patil, Head, Department of Zoology. Dr. Prabha Patil introduced the chief speaker Dr. Vandana Gandhi. Dr. Vandana Gandhi has covered all aspects of Sustainable Menstruation & Impact of Sanitary pads on Health & Environment. She has explained that at present time to focus on the woman health is very mandatory because she has to play number of roles in the family. New age devices should be availed for her to be fit physically. The woman should consider how to use sanitary pads and where to dump it. Right now it is big issue of waste of sanitary pads in India. Some women dump it at any places and that cause to spread germs in the environment. So It becomes challenging for health. Every year India produces plastic sanitary pads near about 13,000 tonnes and it causes to fertile land. There for women should use cloth pad or menstrual cap to save the environment. One cloth pad can be used for 3 to 5 years. It is reusable and safe for good health or environment. Menstrual cup can be used for up to 10 years.

President of this webinar Prin. Dr. D. G. Kanase in his presidential address, he has mentioned about people don't like to speak on menstrual cycle which is considered ominous in rural areas in Maharashtra. Normally menstruation is a natural process that should be accepted in the society by people. This menstrual cycle issue should be mentioned in educational syllabus. The guidance should be given on how to use sanitary pad properly in practical life when offline college is started. It need of time to conduct the awareness programme on the use of sanitary pads in the small villages. once the people get aware about it, automatically it will help to create a good atmosphere in the society. 


