BEST PRACTICE - I

1. TITLE :

Social and Community Outreach initiatives undertaken as Institutional social responsibility.

2. OBJECTIVE OF THE PRACTICE:

- To collaborate with external groups / organizations to enhance the learning experience socially.
- To motivate and train the students to become a part in nation building and development of the society.
- To engage the students in NSS to conduct various awareness programmes.
- To create responsibility in students minds about different social, political, economical and environmental problems.

3. THE CONTEXT:

Dr. Patangrao Kadam Mahavidyalaya, Sangli has always been committed to the cause of humanity and continues to strive for the upliftment of the needy and the poor. Several activities have been organized related to social and community outreach. These activities develop a sensitization among students, faculty and staff.

- The interested students of our College voluntarily enrol in NSS
- Various awareness programmes organized by the respective units on different aspects regularly.
- Trained students are made to participate in various activities at state and national levels.

4. THE PRACTICE:

During the year 2021 – 2022, institute has organised following Social Activities:

- Bharati Vidyapeeth's Dr. Patangrao Kadam Mahavidyalaya, Sangli and Innerwheel Club Sangli jointly organized "Jaipur foot Donation" event on 23rd March, 2021.
- Our College NSS students are given opportunities to do social service in nearby villages.
- The students are participating in many social awareness programmes such as Swachh Bharat, Environment protection and Health Care. They are made as a part of promoting Social welfare of the public.
- Campus Cleaning and Sapling Plantations are practiced regularly to promote environmental awareness.

Health workers from Sangli, Miraj & Kupwad Municipal Corporation vaccinated to People of Sangliwadi and Students, Teaching, Non-teaching staff of our College.
- A Special Camp of National Service Scheme (NSS) of Bharati Vidyapeeth's Dr. Patangrao Kadam Mahavidyalaya, Sangli was conducted from 23rd March 2022 to 29th March, 2022 at Mouje Digraj, Tal-Miraj, Dist-Sangli. This seven day camp cleanliness campaign was carried out in ghat area along the Krishna river with the active 100 NSS volunteers.

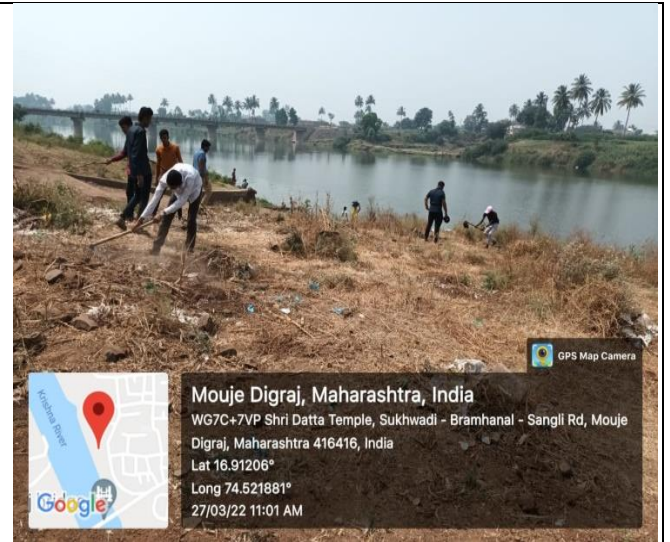

2. OBJECTIVE OF THE PRACTICE

1) The main objective of this practice is to provide an opportunity to explore innovation amongst students to identify and sort real life problems.

2) Quiz competition, Poster presentations, Industrial Visits, encourage students to adopt innovative techniques and develop their ideas and skills.

3. THE CONTEXT

Fun and learn is a self-initiated program which consists of four modules like 1) Quiz competition 2) Poster presentation 3) Webinar 4) Industrial Visits. These four modules provide a great platform to display the knowledge and skills you have amassed over the years. Students go through a series of brainstorming sessions, rapid problem solving sequences and experience a totally diverse form of learning, which they usually don't practice in their schools or colleges. It creates interest in student for practical application.

4. THE PRACTICE:

In Fun and learn we have taken different initiative for the development of students like:

1) Quiz Competition - 28/10/2021: District level Quiz competition on HIV, AIDS and Tuberculosis was conducted by Microbiology department in collaboration with District AIDS prevention and Control Unit, Civil hospital, Sangli. All Colleges from Sangli district participated in this competition.

2) Poster Presentation - 12/08/2021: Participated in online poster/memes/GIF competition was organized by District Aids Prevention and Control Unit, Sangli on the occasion of International Youth day.

3) Webinar - 11/04/2022: One day online webinar on “Need of Biodiversity Conservation for the Sustainable Development” was organized by the Department of Zoology and Internal Quality Assurance cell.

4) Industrial Visit - The Industrial Visit is organized by Department of Chemistry, Bharati Vidyapeeth's Dr. Patangrao Kadam Mahavidyalaya, Sangli, for M.Sc-II (2021-2022) Analytical Chemistry Students at Goa University and PQS Training Laboratory, Goa on 27th, 28th April, 2022.

6. PROBLEMS ENCOUNTERED AND RESOURCES REQUIRED:

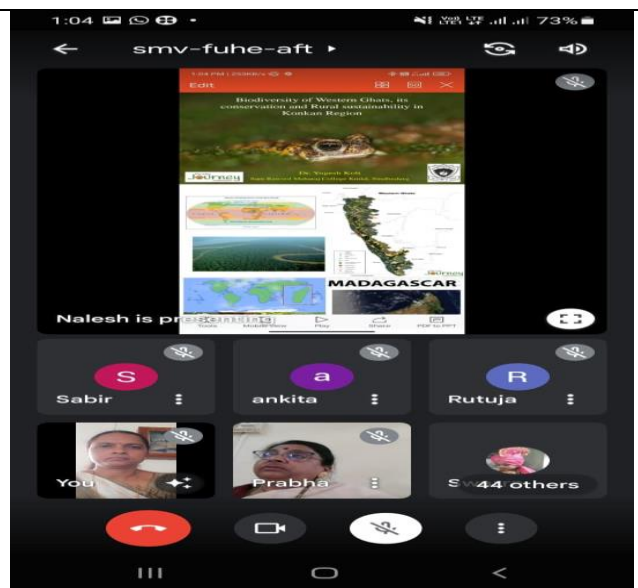

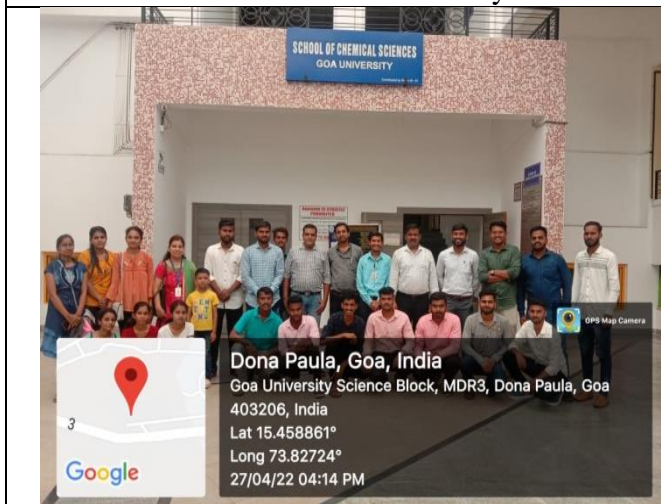
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
