## **Action Taken Report**

## Feedback by students

The feedback response from students is considered while syllabi revision, every three years, designed by Shivaji University, Kolhapur. The response of majority of students regarding design and review of syllabus was found to be good (more than 81 % students thought that the syllabus was satisfactory). Students requested curriculum to incorporate more tutorials, field projects and industrial exposure for better understanding and placement.

The feedback report was sent to the University.

#### Feedback by Teachers

The syllabi are designed by Shivaji University, Kolhapur. The feedback response from teachers is given significance when the syllabi are revised every three years.

The response of majority of teachers regarding design and review of syllabus was very good (more than 85 % teachers find the syllabus satisfactory). Teachers, who are syllabus revision committee members, participate in revising the syllabi. College teachers attend revised syllabus workshops organized by various collges, in collaboration with the University. The feedback of teachers is collected during these workshops and sent to the University. Around 92 % of teachers found the syllabus satisfactory. Teachers suggested that the syllabus content is good and most of the courses are designed with strong fundamentals, good subject knowledge and modern technology to provide job relevance and applicability to real life solutions.
